When your group is finished you will be responsible to present your findings to the class and to be able to hand in a final copy of your categories.

- 1. **Geography:** identifying where your group lived in relation to the current United States
- 2. Culture: identifying what made your group of people unique
- 3. **Government**: identifying the roles of men and women and leadership
- 4. **History:** identifying important leaders and the impact of the Europeans on their way of living
- 5. **Technology**: identifying inventions that made life easier for your group
- 6. **Shelter**: identifying how climate and way of life influenced the type of shelter your group lived in

If your group finishes early there is a list of projects below that your group could do.


- 1. Build a typical home for your Native American group.
